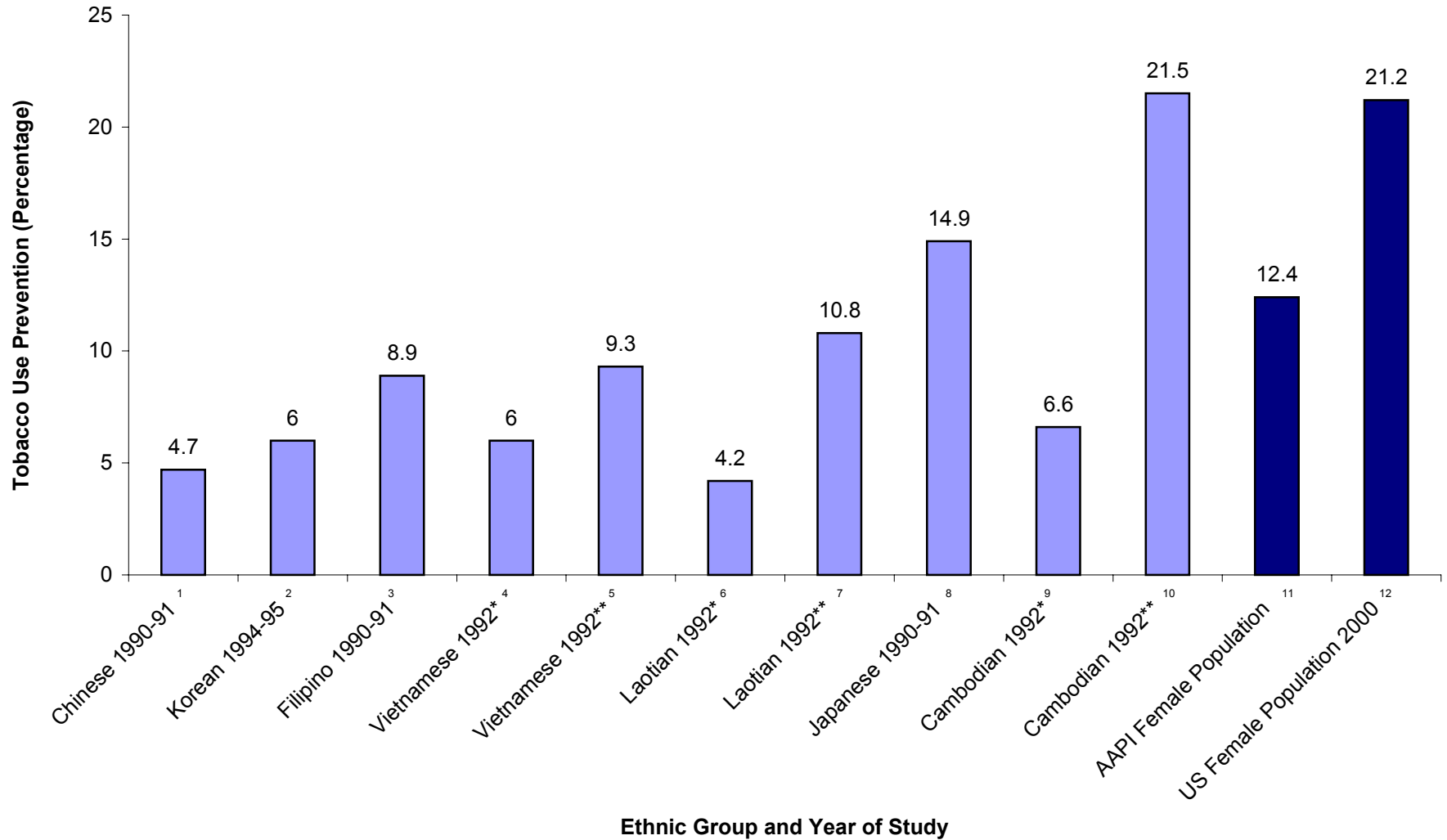


Table 2. Selected local, state, and national findings on the percentage of Asian American women who smoke, overall and by ethnic group
